



MODERN SLAVERY VOLUNTARY STATEMENT

Power Products International Limited supports Transparency in the Supply Chain and the provisions of the Modern Slavery Act 2015. This statement is intended to set out our commitment and policy for the wider supply chain.

Power Products International Limited sources raw materials and component parts globally. Our staff are employed only within the UK, and are not in a category generally considered to be vulnerable to modern slavery in the UK.

We undertake to ensure that sourcing, recruitment, employment and treatment of all employees is carried out in such a way that we remain alert to the risk of modern slavery or human trafficking entering the supply chain, taking steps that are consistent and proportionate with our market sectors and the size of our business.

This includes:

- Only sourcing from known reputable suppliers who, wherever possible, have the necessary measures in place to ensure that modern slavery and human trafficking is not present in the supply chain
- Diligent recruitment through reputable employment & staffing agencies, with fair and robust contractual arrangements for all employees
- Raising awareness within the organisation of the risks of modern slavery and the steps we are taking to ensure our business is continuing to act responsibly.
